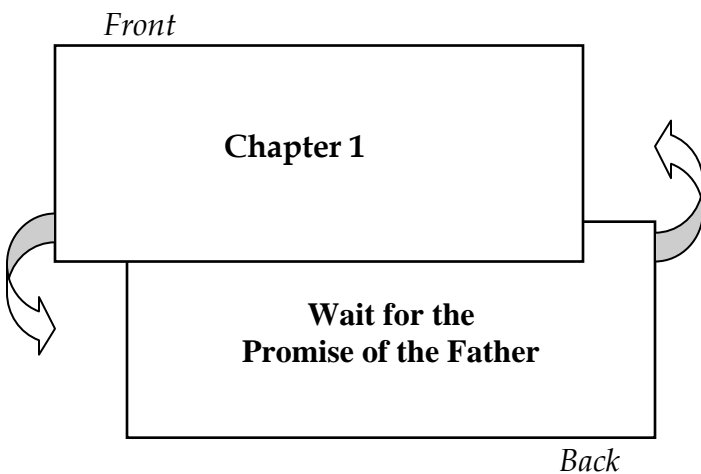


The Book of Acts

Want a good suggestion about how to memorize the contents of each of the twenty-eight chapters in the book of Acts? Prepare twenty-eight flash cards containing the suggested information, and study them frequently. Here's how to prepare the cards.



What you will be looking for on the flash card simply is a leading thought in the chapter that will be easy to remember and serve like putting down a peg around which to revolve the contents of the chapter. The following is a suggested summary of each of the chapters.
